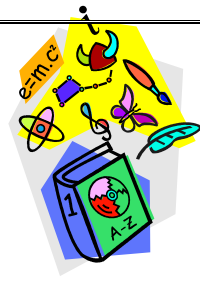


# ***Are you interested in an Academic Intramural?***

If registration in a course exceeds maximum enrollment, students will be entered into a lottery on Dec. 19.

## **HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?**

Cost is \$25.00 per course and a materials fee may also be included. All checks should be made payable to Brown Middle School and sent with registration form. (If minimum enrollments are not met, some courses may be canceled).

Students will be notified if a course has been canceled.  
Students may sign up for one course; second courses will be considered only after all wishing to participate have at least one course.

**Dates:** Thursdays, January 5 – March 15

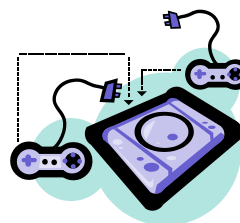
**Time:** 3:00 – 4:00 pm
